



## Articulation Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT, by and between *Hope High School, Hope, Kansas*, and North Central Kansas Technical College, Beloit, Kansas, is made to provide *Construction Pathway* students enrolling in the *Carpentry Cabinetmaking Program* the option to earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree or technical certificate through North Central Kansas Technical College. This agreement is renewable on a yearly basis. It is the hope of the parties that this cooperative effort to offer the Associate of Applied Science Degree or technical certificate will enhance the employment opportunities of the students.

The Associate of Applied Science Degree or technical certificate in *Carpentry/Cabinetmaking* may be granted by North Central Kansas Technical College. The awarding of such a degree or certificate is contingent upon the joint operation of the specific program by the two institutions.

*Hope High School* will provide the necessary course competencies, course syllabus, and text ISBN #'s for all classes relating to *Carpentry/Cabinetmaking* with no exchange of reimbursement between or among the institutions. The *Hope High School* student who takes and passes *all courses relating to Carpentry/Cabinetmaking*, as per the articulation agreement, will be awarded a *tuition waiver equal to the current tuition rate for 2 credit hours* in the *Carpentry/Cabinetmaking Program*. The student receiving the waiver will still be required to attend all classes in the *Carpentry/Cabinetmaking Program*.

Students must complete the remaining hours of credit in residence at North Central Kansas Technical College in a degree or certificate program. (Note: Only a maximum of 6 hours can be considered for an articulation agreement.)

Students must successfully complete the competencies in the high school articulated course(s) with a final percentage of **87%** or better to qualify for scholarship consideration. Instructors need to provide a completed competency profile to the NCKTC instructor who articulated the agreement.

This agreement may be revised by mutual agreement and shall be modified in the event of cancellation, discontinuance, or disapproval of any course or program by the Kansas Board of Regents.

Any change in high school or college staff related to this agreement must result in a review of the agreement or the agreement will be considered void.

Both parties agree to evaluate this program on an annual basis in the context of student benefits, program efficiency, and effectiveness.
